## "More Than A Building" Bible Study Lesson

Our church will share a special lesson in our Youth and Adult Sunday School classes on Sunday morning, October 30. For some it is a call to Christian ministry, and to others it is a call to a secular vocation. In either case, God sends us forth to be His messenger to the community in which we live.

### **Our Need**

Our pressing need is for new educational, general community, and ministry space to replace the essential space that we lost when we removed older portions of the building. Our vision is to provide next generation space for our students' and children's ministries, and a large multipurpose space useful in cultivating community among our Eldorado First Baptist Church family, as well as the community of Eldorado.

### **Our Cost**

We have cost estimates of \$850,000, although we will not know the actual cost until closer to construction. With currently over \$300,000 on hand, that leaves an estimated need of \$550,000 to still be funded.

### **Our Project**

Our multi-purpose addition will create a perfect space for hosting meals, fellowships, events, and community outreach. The upstairs will host the next generation space with a large meeting area for our student ministry. The children's space will include five classrooms and nursery with shared restrooms. Adjacent to the multi-purpose space will be large men's and women's restrooms, kitchen, and storage space.

### **Our Goal**

Working together to follow the call of God on our individual lives will maximize the amount we raise. Our goal is to raise as many dollars as possible to reduce the amount we will have to borrow to complete the project.

### What should I give?
