The Call of God

Throughout the Scriptures, there is the emphasis of God's call on our lives. In the Old Testament, God places a call on Moses to lead the people, on leremiah to prophesy, on lonah to preach, and on countless others to serve in a variety of ways. Then, in the New Testament, again the call comes to men like Peter, James, and John, to name only a few. What is noticeable each time is that the call is different. They are called from specific life roles to come and serve Him in specific ways. Some were called early in life, while others were called later in life. But in every case, God had a plan for their lives. Nothing has changed today. God still places a call on our lives to come and serve Him. In Ephesians, we read, "And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers." We are still called from different places at different times to do different ministries.

Look at the Scriptures and you will find that He uses our lives, but He also uses the material things He has placed in our trust. People who live in the Word of God, hear the Call of God. Remember, the Word is "alive and active" and it always points people to God. What is the Word saying to you? What role does the Call of God have in a campaign process? We are asking you to not only talk to God, but to position yourself to hear the Call of God on your life. Sometimes that means we need to be in our prayer closet. Sometimes we need to take off our shoes because we are on holy ground. Sometimes He will speak in a still, small voice or through someone else. In any case, we do not want to miss His Call.
