The *EVENTS* of Jesus in His final hours on earth provide the *EVIDENCE* we need to see Him as not just a great teacher but as the One & Only Son of God who rescued us from our sin!

Three \_\_\_\_\_ from Jesus during these trials that display the right \_\_\_\_\_ with the heart of surrender...

1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ His Identity (14:53-65)
